Invitation Letter to contribute a talk to the AT3 Parallel Session of the MG14

I would like to invite you to **contribute a 30 minute talk** in the **AT3 Parallel Session** at the **Fourteenth Marcel Grossmann Meeting (MG14)** on Recent Developments in Theoretical and Experimental General Relativity, Gravitation, and Relativistic Field Theory that will take place at the University of Rome Sapienza, 12-18th July, 2015. The MG14 will be celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Einstein equations as well as the International Year of Light under the aegis of the United Nations.
